	Provide responsive and engaged services to society and to communities through activities such as dissemination of information, collaborative policy analysis, methodological innovations and inter-disciplinary cooperation across a wide range of issues	
Guiding Documents	Basic texts of the 2003 Convention for the Safeguarding of the Intangible Cultural Heritage Statutes of the APHEN-ICH (2018)	
Membership	Membership shall be broadly inclusive across the higher education sector within the Asia-Pacific region. The Members of the Network shall be higher education institutions with programs associated with the safeguarding of intangible cultural heritage. ICHCAP, UNESCO Bangkok Office and the Secretariat of the APHEN-ICH also make essential contributions to the network.	
Secretariat	The Secretariat of the APHEN-ICH coordinates the network. The Secretariat is based in the Korea National University of Cultural Heritage, the only university in Korea that established the Department of Intangible Cultural Heritage Studies. (Term: 2018-2020)
